Estimation Checklist

- 1. Is what's being estimated clearly defined?
- 2. Does the estimate include all the kinds of work needed to complete the task?
- 3. Does the estimate include all the functionality areas needed to complete the task?
- 4. Is the estimate broken down into enough detail to expose hidden work?
- 5. Did you look at documented facts (written notes) from past work rather than estimating purely from memory?
- 6. Is the productivity assumed in the estimate similar to what has been achieved on similar assignments?
- 7. Does the estimate include a Best Case, Worst Case, and Most Likely Case?

- 8. Is the Worst Case really the worst case? Does it need to be made even worse?
- 9. Is the Expected Case Computed appropriately from the other cases?
- 10. Have the assumptions in the estimate been documented?

Calculate the Expected Case with: Expected Case = [BestCase + (4 * MostLikelyCase) + WorstCase] / 6
